

# correction dose

This is the insulin dose you take for high blood glucose during the day and at bedtime.

**Meal time:** 1 unit per 50mg/dL over 200

**Bedtime:** 1 unit per 50mg/dL over 250

blood glucose	daytime	bedtime
Under 201	0	0
201-250	1	0
251-300	2	1
301-350	3	2
351-400	4	3
401-450	5	4
451-500	6	5
501-550	7	6
551-600	8	7
Over 600	9	8

Only give correction dose if it has been **more than 2-3 hours** since the last dose of fast-acting insulin.
